## **Chaos on the River** 11.50 Campari, Orgeat, Lemon

The British Empire was expanding and steam power had arrived. All this meant more trade and pandemonium on the river. Collisions were frequent and plundering was rife. The Port of London was in chaos and there was a desperate need for more docks with wider and deeper shores. First to be built were the East and West India Docks, which helped relieve for a while the pressure on cargo berths for London.

## **The British Moai** 12.00 Bacardi Carta Blanca, HM Falernum, Amaro d'Angostura, Guanabana, Lime, Coconut

At the beginning of 1868, during the golden age of the British Empire, Commodore Richard Powell who was captain of HMS Topaze removed the Hoa Hakananai statue from a cliff top on Easter Island. He donated the seven foot basalt figure to Queen Victoria when the ship returned to the London Docks the following year. Nowadays we can admire the majestic Moai at the main entrance of the British Museum.

## **The Old Sailor** 11.50 Woodford Reserve Straight Bourbon, Galliano, Fernet Branca, Moscovado

The stories of an Old Sailor called Jack Mason is part of the Theodore Thinker series, in which Theodore recalls various tales told to him of adventures on the Oceans and London Docks by Jack. This was originally a children's book printed back in 1855.

## **The East India Co.** 11.50 Umeshu Plum Wine, Martini Ambrato, Port 10 y.o. Orange Flower Water, Peychaud

The Honourable East India Company was the greatest of all merchant trading companies. For over 200 years, it monopolized trade between England and the Far East and rose to account for half of the world's trade. To protect its interests, it even developed its own army and the company ending up taking control over large parts of the Indian subcontinent, colonised parts of Southeast Asia and Hong Kong after a war with Qing China.

## **The Old Venus** 12.00 1800 Silver Tequila, Vanilla & Passion Curd, Lime, Prosecco & Passion Foam

The growth in London's maritime trade during the 18th century brought more and more ships to the wharves and quays. With the ships came sailors and inevitably there was an increase of the number of brothels to meet the growing demand. Those brothels were usually run by women who were able to improve their status as self-made business ladies.

## The Red Seal

The Botanist Gin, Jasmine Dragon Pearl Tea, Pomegranate, Tattinger Champagne

The use of wax in seals did not take place until the Victorian Ages. Originally used only by eminent individuals such as bishops, monarchs and royal spokespeople to authenticate documents, by the 17th century wax seals became more widespread and were being used by guilds, aristocrats and eventually traders and merchants to identify their commodities before been stored in warehouses.

## The Flying Dutchman

DeBorgen Genever Cornwine, Amaro Lucano, Lime, Mandarin, Ginger Beer, Peroni

The Flying Dutchman was a legendary ghost ship that never made it back to the harbour. The myth is likely to have originated from the 17th-century golden age of the East India Company, when a Dutch ship sailed from the London Docks onto the Atlantic Ocean and never came back.

## The 3 Muscateers

Remy Martin 1738 Cognac, Pisco, Lemon, Muscat, Egg White, Angostura

The Import of *Muscat* grapes became popular in London during the 17<sup>th</sup> century and Warehouse Nr.1 at East India Docks was handling most of the trade. In the same period of time, the spirits made of *Muscat* grapes as Cognac and Pisco became popular amongst the high-class society.

## Madama Butterfly

VII Hills Gin inf. Butterfly, Cointreau, Lemon, Lavender & Eucaliptus, Egg White, Angostura

London's excursion pleasure steamers were known as "Butterfly boats" by deep-sea sailors. Between 1919-1939 there was the heyday of the big Thames passenger steamers, where thousands of sightseers and holidaymakers were carried between London to the coast, passing by Canary Wharf.

## The Dove

Maestro Dobel Humito Tequila, St.Germain liqueur, Grapefruit Shrub, Lime, Peychaud, Soda

During the 17<sup>th</sup> century the British Imperial Fleet had established itself as the world's leading fleet. A daily demand of new ships was supplied in the London Docks, where hundreds of workers were employed to build it. As part of the ship launching ceremony, a white dove was freed as a sign good luck.

## The Ratcliffe Fire

London's docks, with their industrial buildings and warehouses, were the scene of many fires. In July 1794, an incident at Ratcliffe, resulted in London's biggest fire between the Great Fire of 1666 and the Blitz of 1940.

## The Sea Perfume

Back in their good old days, Sailors had to wait on shore; grounded for months, awaiting for their next expedition to start. As months were passing by, they were getting nostalgic and melancholy thinking about that beloved Ocean breeze. To cope with that lonely feeling, they used to carry on them a small leather flask, filled up with ocean water as a constant reminder of their glorious sailing adventures, awaiting for the next one to begin.

## Sons of Mayahuel

1800 Silver Tequila, Cointreau, Verjous, Lime, Agave, Sauvignon Blanc

The ancient Divinity known as *Mayahuel* is considered the Goddess of Agave and the mother of all Mexicans. The British Empire and Mexico have been in trading for centuries, fighting side by side against the French Empire during the 19th century establishing a solid import route between the American Colonies and the London Docks.

## The Dark Whale

Kraken Spice Rum, Amaro d'Angostura, Lime, Mandarin, Mint, Ginger Beer

From 1775, London's whaling trade developed. Ships fished the South Atlantic and Pacific for whale's sperm, southern whales and seals. In London, at the peak of activity in 1821, was the largest harbour trading in Whales in the world.

## The Rise of Steam

Monkey Shoulder Whisky, Smoked rooibos tea syrup, Lemon, Soda

The first steamships were small and suitable only for short passages. However, within three decades, technological advances had established the future of steam. During the second half of the 19th century, Steamships captured many of the cargoes carried on long ocean routes by sailing ships.

By mid-19th century, much of the trade of the London Harbour was seasonal and there was very little notice when any ship was arriving. This meant that the demand for men varied from day to day, even from hour to hour. The dock companies only took on workers when the trade was picking up. Most of the workforce employed was from Eastern Europe and they brought to London their culture of drinking white spirits served with pickled vegetables, a heritage we can still find nowadays.

### **The Bloody Jolly Rodger**
